Hints and Tips for Entering Exhibits into the Daylesford Show

It can be fun and challenging to enter your work or produce (exhibits) in an agricultural show and a great way to support the local Daylesford Show.

Here are some things judges look for when judging that will help you with preparing your exhibits.

FARM PRODUCE

Good quality produce

Free from disease and damage

VEGETABLES & FRUIT

- Exhibits which are typical of the variety mentioned in the schedule
- Fresh, crisp and clean produce of uniform shape and size.
- Exhibits free from disease, insect or other damage
- JAMS, JELLIES, PRESERVES, RELISHES

Freshness

- Jam which is true to fruit colour
- Jellies which are clear and transparent
- · Jars that are clean
- Sauces, chutneys, pickles and relishes which are true to type and have a bright natural appearance

COOKING

• Appearance, finish, colour, texture, flavour, aroma

CAKES

- Fine even texture without airholes
- Even colour on top sides and base
- Height in proportion to tin size

KNITTING, CROCHET, SEWING, EMBROIDERY

- Crisp, clean well-presented work
- Originality
- Well-finished work inside and out.

FLOWERS

- Blooms at the peak of development
- Clear, bright colour

- · Strong, straight stems
- · Clean, healthy foliage

FLORAL ART

- A well-balanced exhibit which conforms exactly to what the schedule requires
- Good clean material
- An attractive, complimentary container
