1. Trumpet daffodil, single colour
2. Trumpet daffodil, bicolour
3. Double daffodil
4. Miniature daffodil (smaller than 50mm in diameter)
5. Split corona daffodil
6. Banded daffodil
7. Vase or bowl of daffodils

B JONQUILS - Jonquilla or Tazetta cultivars, multiple blooms per stem.

8. Jonquil, single, white perianth, yellow or orange cup
9. Jonquil, single, yellow or orange
10. Jonquil, double, any colour
11. Vase or bowl of jonquils

C HELLEBORES – single stem

12. White, single
13. White, double
14. Green, single
15. Green, double
16. Pink-burgundy, single
17. Pink-burgundy, double
18. Purple-black, single
19. Purple-black- double
20. Bicolour, single
21. Bicolour, double
22. Any other colour
23. Vase or bowl of hellebores

D WINTER FLOWERING BULBS (OTHER THAN ABOVE)

24. Any winter flowering bulb, blue or purple
25. Any winter flowering bulb, red or pink
26. Any winter flowering bulb, yellow or orange
27. Any winter flowering bulb, white or cream.
28. Vase or bowl of winter flowering bulbs, other than daffodils or jonquils

E CAMELLIAS – To be judged as flowering tree or shrub

29. Any red camellia
30. Any pink camellia

- F AUSTRALIAN NATIVE PLANTS
- 34. Australian Native flower, other than tree or shrub
 - 35. Single cut of native flower from tree or shrub
 - 36. Two cuts of native flower from tree or shrub similar colour
 - 37. Three cuts of native tree or shrub distinct varieties.
 - 38. Container of Australian natives any varieties
- G PROTEAS
- 39. Individual bloom
 - 40. Container of proteas
- H FOLIAGE
- 41. Container green foliage
 - 42. Container of native foliage
 - 43. Container of exotic foliage
- I POT PLANT, MAY HAVE FLOWERS, BERRIES OR FRUIT
- 44. Australian native
 - 45. Any potted plant other than Australian native
 - 46. Flowering pot plant
- J FLORAL ART, FLOWER ARRANGEMENT (flowers need not be grown by exhibitors)
- 47. Small hand-held posy
 - 48. Hand-held bouquet.
 - 49. Floating arrangement to fit standard dinner plate.
 - 50. Single container, maximum size 750mm in length, width or height.
 - 51. Installation with 3 containers; maximum size 750 mm in length, width or height.

- 52. Container of anything not specifically mentioned above.
